CHAPTER 74

An Act respecting Interprovincial Pipe Line (Quebec) Inc.

[Assented to 14 December 1992]

Preamble WHEREAS Interprovincial Pipe Line (Quebec) Inc. is a body corporate duly incorporated on 27 August 1990 under the Canada Business Corporations Act (R.S.C., 1985, chapter C-44) and having a place of business in Montréal;

Whereas Interprovincial Pipe Line (Quebec) Inc. intends to construct, operate and maintain a pipeline to be used for the transmission of oil and oil by-products from and within the area of the city of Québec to and within the area of the city of Montréal;

Whereas this project is in the public interest and it is necessary for its realization that Interprovincial Pipe Line (Quebec) Inc. be granted the power of expropriation and a right of access to certain immovables;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Acquisition
by expro-
priation

1. Interprovincial Pipe Line (Quebec) Inc., in the absence of an agreement, may acquire, by expropriation, any immovable or real right with a view to the construction, operation and maintenance of a pipeline to be used for the transmission of oil and oil by-products from and within the area of the city of Québec to and within the area of the city of Montréal.

Such expropriations are governed by the Expropriation Act (R.S.Q., chapter E-24).

Entry by
represent-
ative

2. A duly authorized representative of the corporation may enter at any reasonable hour onto any immovable to effect any work

for the construction, operation and maintenance of the pipeline upon condition that the corporation indemnify any person for any damage caused by its representative.

Identifica-
tion

This representative shall, upon request, identify himself and show a document attesting to his capacity.

Time limit

3. If the construction of the pipeline has not commenced within ten years of the date of the coming into force of this Act, the latter ceases to have any effect.

Coming into
force

4. This Act comes into force on 14 December 1992.
