CHAPTER 80

An Act respecting Consolidated Bowling Ltd.

[Assented to 22 December 1992]

Preamble WHEREAS Consolidated Bowling Ltd., a company incorporated by letters patent under the Great Seal issued on 1 February 1961 by the Lieutenant-Governor under the Quebec Companies Act (R.S.Q., 1941, chapter 276), was dissolved on 29 December 1973 under the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., 1964, chapter 273);

Whereas, since 29 December 1973, Consolidated Bowling Ltd. has always complied with all legislation applying to it, except the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22);

Whereas the corporation is not entitled to resumption under the Companies Information Act;

Whereas it is expedient to authorize the filing of a request for the resumption of Consolidated Bowling Ltd. under section 11 of the Companies Information Act;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Request for resumption **1.** Any interested person may, in accordance with section 11 of the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22), make a request in writing to the Minister for Finance for the resumption of Consolidated Bowling Ltd.

Granting of request **2.** The Minister for Finance may grant, in accordance with the Companies Information Act, a request made to him pursuant to section 1.

Coming into force **3.** This Act comes into force on 22 December 1992.
