CHAPTER 45

An Act to amend the Act to establish the Commission on the Political and Constitutional Future of Québec

[Assented to 2 November 1990]

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1990, c. 34,
s. 5, am.

1. Section 5 of the Act to establish the Commission on the Political and Constitutional Future of Québec (1990, chapter 34) is amended

(1) by replacing the word “twelve” in the first line of paragraph 3 by the word “thirteen”;

(2) by striking out the words “or the cultural sector” at the end of subparagraph *e* of paragraph 3;

(3) by inserting, after subparagraph *e* of paragraph 3, the following subparagraph:

“(f) one person from the cultural sector;”;

(4) by adding, at the end, the following paragraph:

Members

“Notwithstanding the appointment process provided for in the first paragraph, the president of the Fédération des commissions scolaires catholiques du Québec and the president of the Union des artistes are, by virtue respectively of subparagraphs *e* and *f* of paragraph 3 of the first paragraph, the first persons to become members of the Commission, and shall be members thereof from 2 November 1990.”

2. Section 8 of the said Act is amended

(1) by inserting the words “or in paragraph 4 of that section” after the figure “5” in the second line of the first paragraph;

(2) by inserting the words “of paragraph 3 or, as the case may be, under paragraph 4” after the word “subparagraph” in the fifth line of the first paragraph.

3. Section 24 of the said Act is amended by replacing the word “eighteen” in the first line by the word “nineteen”.

4. This Act comes into force on 2 November 1990.
