CHAPTER 2

Appropriation Act No. 5, 1988-89

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

\$270 650 700
for
1988-89

1. The Government may take out of the consolidated revenue fund a sum not exceeding \$270 650 700 to defray a part of the expenses of Québec proposed in the supplementary estimates for the fiscal year 1988-89 as laid before the National Assembly, not otherwise provided for, being the amount of each of the estimates to be voted for various programs set forth in the Schedule to this Act.
