CHAPTER 44

An Act to amend the Act to promote the parole of inmates

[Assented to 13 December 1988]

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- c. L-1.1,
s. 3, am.
- 1.** Section 3 of the Act to promote the parole of inmates (R.S.Q., chapter L-1.1) is amended by replacing the word “six” in the first line by the word “seven”.
- c. L-1.1,
s. 9, am.
- 2.** Section 9 of the said Act is amended by adding, at the end, the following paragraphs:
- Substitute
- “Where a full-time member is temporarily absent or unable to act, the chairman may designate a part-time member to replace the member who is absent or unable to act, until a person is appointed by the Government under the first paragraph.
- Full-time member
- Any person appointed or designated under this section is deemed to be a full-time member for the purposes of section 11.”
- Coming into force
- 3.** This Act comes into force on 13 December 1988.
