CHAPTER 129

An Act respecting the village of Saint-Gédéon

[Assented to 23 March 1987]

Preamble WHEREAS it is expedient to validate the imposition and levy by the village of Saint-Gédéon of a compensation used, in particular, to repay loans contracted under by-laws 50 and 50A of the village of Saint-Gédéon;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Compensation **1.** The compensation imposed and levied by the corporation of the village of Saint-Gédéon for the fiscal years 1975 to 1985 to provide for the maintenance and management of the waterworks and sewer systems and the payment of interest on and repayment of the principal of loans made under by-laws 50 and 50A is hereby declared valid.

Pending cases **2.** This Act shall not affect cases pending, decisions made or judgments rendered on or before 12 July 1986.

Coming into force **3.** This Act comes into force on 23 March 1987.
