CHAPTER 50

An Act respecting the town of Brossard

[Assented to 1 May 1985]

Preamble WHEREAS it is in the interest of the town of Brossard and necessary for the proper administration of its affairs that it be granted the special powers provided for in this Act;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Number of electoral districts **1.** Notwithstanding section 10 of the Act respecting elections in certain municipalities (R.S.Q., chapter E-2.1), the number of electoral districts for the general election of the mayor and councillors of the town of Brossard in 1986 must not be less than 10 nor more than 16.

Application The division into electoral districts made in accordance with the first paragraph applies for the purposes of the first general election following the coming into force of the by-law dividing the town into electoral districts or of the decision of the Commission de la représentation, as the case may be, and for the purposes of every subsequent election held before the following general election.

Coming into force **2.** This Act comes into force on 1 May 1985.
