CHAPTER 1

An Act to amend the Act respecting the conditions of employment and the pension plan of the Members of the National Assembly

[Assented to 20 March 1984]

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 7 of the Act respecting the conditions of employment and the pension plan of the Members of the National Assembly (R.S.Q., chapter C-52.1) is amended by replacing subparagraphs 12 and 13 of the first paragraph by the following subparagraphs:

“(12) a Member appointed to act as chairman of a committee shall receive on an annual basis an indemnity equal to 25% of the annual indemnity;

“(13) a Member appointed to act as vice-chairman of a committee shall receive on an annual basis an indemnity equal to 20% of the annual indemnity;”.

Exception

2. This Act shall operate notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 7 to 15 of the Constitution Act, 1982 (Schedule B of the Canada Act, chapter 11 in the 1982 volume of the Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom).

Coming into
force

3. This Act comes into force on 20 March 1984.
