CHAPTER 69

An Act respecting the city of Beaconsfield

[Assented to 22 June 1983]

Preamble WHEREAS it is in the interest of the city of Beaconsfield that its charter, chapter 109 of the statutes of 1953-1954, amended by chapter 89 of the statutes of 1957-1958, be again amended;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Annexation **1.** That part of the bed of the St Lawrence river extending in front of the present territory of the city of Beaconsfield, including the beach and deep water lots, islands, wharves, jetties, breakwaters, retaining walls, marinas and other present or future structures, the whole comprised between the extension of the southwest line of lot 1 of the cadastre of the parish of Pointe-Claire and lot 2 of the cadastre of the village of Pointe-Claire, the left bank of the St Lawrence river, being the average high water line as it existed in 1910, and a line parallel to the said left bank and situated at a perpendicular distance of 300 metres from it, is annexed to the territory of the city of Beaconsfield.

Effect **2.** Section 1 has effect from 30 June 1910.

Effect **3.** The retroactive effect of section 2 does not affect any judgment rendered before 22 June 1983 or any case pending on that date.

Building permit **4.** Notwithstanding the retroactive effect of section 2, the building inspector of the city shall issue the building permit being the subject of the judgment of the Superior Court of the district of Montréal, bearing number 500-05-002124-780, rendered on 10 October 1979.

Coming into force **5.** This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
