CHAPTER 33

An Act to favour the institution of proceedings
related to the use of urea formaldehyde foam insulation

[Assented to 19 December 1981]

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the National
Assembly of Québec, enacts as follows:

Proceed-
ings.

1. In no case may proceedings related to the use of urea formaldehyde foam insulation brought on or before 19 December 1981 or before 1 July 1982 be dismissed on the ground that they are prescribed or were not brought with reasonable diligence.

Coming
into force.

2. This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
