## CHAPTER 50

### An Act respecting the city of Gatineau

[Assented to 18 June 1981]

Preamble. WHEREAS it is in the interest of the city of Gatineau that its charter be amended;

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Québec, enacts as follows:

s. 18, am. **1.** Section 11 of the charter of the city of Gatineau, enacted by section 18 of chapter 88 of the statutes of 1974, is amended by adding, at the end, the following paragraphs:

Annual remuneration. “Each member of the committee receives, as annual remuneration for his services in that capacity and over and above any other amount received as member of the council, the amount of the annual remuneration of a councillor of the municipality.

Terms. The council determines by resolution the terms of payment of this sum, one-third of which is paid as an indemnity for part of the expenses attaching to the office in question.”

Executive committee. **2.** From the general election of 1983, the executive committee established pursuant to section 11 of the charter of the city of Gatineau, enacted by section 18 of chapter 88 of the statutes of 1974, is deemed to be an executive committee established according to subdivision 5.1 of Division IV of the Cities and Towns Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-19). The executive committee is composed of three members.

Effect. **3.** Section 1 has effect from 1 January 1981 and ceases to have effect from the general election of 1983.

in 1983. **4.** Section 11 of the charter of the city of Gatineau, enacted by section 18 of chapter 88 of the statutes of 1974, is repealed from the general election of 1983.

Coming into force. **5.** This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
