



CHAPTER 106

An Act respecting the Nicholas (Nicolas) Minailo estate

[Assented to 22 June 1979]

Preamble. WHEREAS Nicholas (Nicolas) Minailo died on 24 February 1977, at the age of 88, leaving a writing in respect of which the children of his predeceased wife, whom he regarded as his own, have applied unsuccessfully for probate, the said writing bearing only the initial of the deceased;

Whereas, notwithstanding that defect of form, it is expedient that the writing be probated as if it were a holograph will;

Therefore, Her Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Assemblée nationale du Québec, enacts as follows:

Equivalence to a signature.

1. The initial on the writing that was the subject of the judgment respecting the application for probate of a holograph will under number 14-001826-775 of the records of the Superior Court for the district of Montreal is, for the purposes of judicial probate, equivalent to a signature.

Coming into force.

2. This act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
