



## CHAPTER 124

An Act to amend the Charter of the city of Hull

[Assented to 21 December 1979]

Pream-  
ble.

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the city of Hull that its charter be amended;

Her Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Assemblée nationale du Québec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 55 of the Charter of the city of Hull (1975, c. 94) is amended by replacing subsection 1 by the following subsection:

Convention  
centre.

**“55.** (1) The city is authorized to acquire, lease, construct or assist in the construction of immoveables in its territory for the establishment and operation of a convention centre; for such purposes, it may, without other approval than that of the Commission municipale du Québec and that of the Ministre des affaires municipales, contract loans up to two million seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars including financing costs.

Borrowing.

The city is also authorized to borrow the sums necessary to acquire the furnishings and the non-incorporated equipment of the convention centre without other approval than that of the Commission municipale du Québec and that of the Ministre des affaires municipales.

Adminis-  
tration.

The city may take charge of the administration of the convention centre or, with the authorization of the Government, entrust any person, company or corporation with that administration and sign any agreement for the purposes of this section.”

Coming  
into force.

**2.** This act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
