



CHAPTER 40

An Act to again amend the Watercourses Act

[Assented to 22 December 1978]

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Assemblée nationale du Québec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 2 of the Watercourses Act (Revised Statutes, 1964, chapter 84), amended by section 1 of chapter 24 of the statutes of 1974, is again amended:

(a) by inserting after the date “1974” in the second line of the third paragraph the following words and numbers: “until 22 December 1978”;

(b) by adding at the end the following paragraphs:

Sale, lease,
etc., of
bank,
shore, bed
of river,
lake, sea.

“From 22 December 1978, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may make a regulation to authorize the Ministre des richesses naturelles, on such conditions as he may determine, to grant an alienation, lease or occupation licence on a property mentioned in the preceding paragraph and agree on a limit. In the cases not provided for in that regulation, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize, on such conditions as he may determine in each case, the alienation, exchange, lease or occupation, and the limits of such property.

Adjacent
land.

He may also, in the same manner, authorize the Minister to agree on a limit of such property with the owner of the adjacent land.”

Coming
into force.

2. This act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
