



## CHAPTER 51

### An Act to amend the Public Works Act

[Assented to 22 December 1978]

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Assemblée nationale du Québec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 8 of the Public Works Act (Revised Statutes, 1964, chapter 138) is replaced by the following section:

Calling for  
tenders.

**“8.** The Minister shall call for tenders by public advertisement for the execution of all works done by contract and the estimated cost of which exceeds sixty-five thousand dollars, except

(a) in cases of emergency where the safety of persons or property is involved and where delay would be injurious to the public interest; or

(b) in cases where the execution of the works must be entrusted to a public utility firm; or

(c) in cases where the execution of the works is entrusted to a municipal corporation or to an urban or regional community; or

(d) in cases of works to equip or re-equip a rented building where the contract is made with the owner; or

(e) in cases of restoration or renovation works where it is impossible to identify and describe such works with precision.”

**2.** Section 11 of the said act is amended by replacing the words “or immoveable property” in the third and fourth lines by the following: “, immoveable property or immoveable real right”.

s. 13, am.      **3.** Section 13 of the said act is amended by inserting the words “, immoveable real right” after the word “property” in the fifth line.

into force.      **4.** This act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
