An Act respecting Municipalité de Saint-Joseph-de-Coleraine

WHEREAS between 15 May 1977 and 27 February 1992, over half of the special sittings of the council of Municipalité de Saint-Joseph-de-Coleraine were not convened in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Code of Québec (R.S.Q., chapter C-27.1);

Whereas the planning by-laws of the municipality were not passed in accordance with the provisions of the said Code;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No by-law or resolution passed by the council of Municipalité de Saint-Joseph-de-Coleraine between 15 May 1977 and 27 February 1992 may be invalidated on the ground that the special sitting during which it was passed was not convened in accordance with article 156 of the Municipal Code of Québec (R.S.Q., chapter C-27.1).

2. By-laws 376, 377, 378 and 379, passed by the council of the municipality, may not be invalidated on the ground that they were not passed in accordance with article 445 of the Municipal Code of Québec.

3. Nothing in this Act shall affect a case pending on 6 September 1994.
