EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill amends the Public Buildings Safety Act in order to grant the Government the power to regulate the supervision measures required in public buildings and the qualifications of the persons who are to carry them out. Under the bill, the regulatory provisions relating to these matters are deemed to have been enacted under the new regulatory power and will come into force on the date of assent to this bill.

An Act to amend the Public Buildings Safety Act

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 39 of the Public Buildings Safety Act (R.S.Q., chapter S-3) is amended by adding, after paragraph *c* of subsection 1, the following paragraph:

“(d) The supervision measures required in public buildings and the qualifications of the persons who are to carry them out.”

2. In the Regulation respecting safety in public baths (R.R.Q., 1981, chapter S-3, r. 3), the Regulation respecting passenger ropeways (O.C. 2476-82 of 27 October 1982), the Regulation respecting elevators, escalators, dumbwaiters, moving walks, freight platform lifts and elevating devices for disabled persons (O.C. 1009-88 of 22 June 1988) and the Regulation respecting safety in public buildings (R.R.Q., 1981, chapter S-3, r. 4), the provisions relating to supervision measures required in public buildings and the qualifications of the persons who are to carry them out are deemed to have been enacted in accordance with paragraph *d* of subsection 1 of section 39 of the Public Buildings Safety Act as enacted by section 1 of this Act, on *(insert here the date of assent to this Act)*, and come into force on that date.
