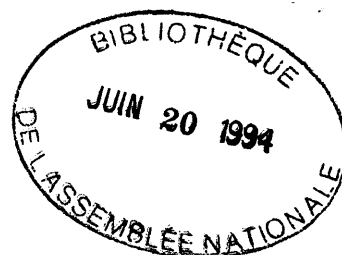

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill amends the Act respecting the National Assembly to confer on the Office the regulatory power to grant moneys for purposes of research and support to a political party represented in the Assembly following the last general election and to a Member sitting as an independent Member.

An Act to amend the Act respecting the National Assembly

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 108 of the Act respecting the National Assembly (R.S.Q., chapter A-23.1) is amended by replacing the first paragraph by the following paragraph:

“108. The Office shall, by regulation, determine the moneys that may be received from the Assembly, for research and support purposes, by the political parties represented in the Assembly following the last general election and by independent Members, and the terms and conditions of payment thereof.”

[[2. The sums required for the administration of this Act shall be taken out of the consolidated revenue fund.]]
