EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill amends the Financial Administration Act and the Act respecting the Ministère des Approvisionnements et Services in order to allow the Government to exempt certain public bodies, without condition, from the application of all regulations made under those Acts in respect of the conditions of contracts made by public bodies and the acquisition and supply of goods and services by such bodies.

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Financial Administration Act (R.S.Q., chapter A-6) is amended by inserting, after section 49.3, the following section:

“49.3.1 The Government, upon the recommendation of the Conseil du trésor and without condition, may exempt a public body, other than a person designated by the National Assembly to perform duties that come under the National Assembly and other than the Commission de la représentation, from the application of all regulations made under section 49.”

2. The Act respecting the Ministère des Approvisionnements et Services (R.S.Q., chapter M-23.01) is amended by inserting, after section 7.5, the following section:

“7.6 The Government, upon the recommendation of the Conseil du trésor and without condition, may exempt a public body, other than a person designated by the National Assembly to perform duties that come under the National Assembly and other than the Commission de la représentation, from the application of all regulations made under section 7.1.”

3. This Act will come into force on the date fixed by the Government.
