EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill amends the Act respecting the National Assembly in order to enable the Office of the National Assembly to determine, by regulation, the amounts of money that may be received for purposes of research and support by a Member sitting as an independent Member and not belonging to a political party represented in the Assembly.

The bill also provides that such a regulation of the Office may have effect from a date not prior to 3 September 1992.

Bill 73

An Act to again amend the Act respecting the National Assembly

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 108.1 of the Act respecting the National Assembly (R.S.Q., chapter A-23.1), enacted by section 1 of the Act to amend the Act respecting the National Assembly (1992, chapter 7), is replaced by the following section:

“108.1 The Office shall, by regulation, determine the moneys that may be received from the Assembly, for the purposes of research and support, by a Member sitting as an independent Member on *(insert here the date of assent to this Act)* who is not a member of a political party represented in the Assembly, and the terms and conditions of payment thereof.

This section shall cease to have effect at the end of the Thirty-fourth Legislature.”

2. A regulation adopted by the Office of the National Assembly under section 1 may have effect from a date not prior to 3 September 1992.

[[3. The sums required for the carrying out of this Act shall be taken out of the consolidated revenue fund.]]

4. This Act comes into force on *(insert here the date of assent to this Act)*.
