EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this bill is to amend various legislative provisions so that Canada Day may be kept and observed on 1 July.

Bill 190

An Act to amend various legislative provisions concerning Canada Day

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 60 of the Act respecting labour standards (R.S.Q., chapter N-1.1), replaced by section 18 of chapter 73 of the statutes of 1990, is amended by replacing paragraph 4 by the following paragraph:

“(4) 1 July;”.

2. Section 3 of the Act respecting hours and days of admission to commercial establishments (1990, chapter 30), amended by section 72 of chapter 73 of the statutes of 1990, is again amended by replacing paragraph 5 by the following paragraph:

“(5) 1 July;”.
