An Act respecting Abar Realities Inc.

WHEREAS Abar Realities Inc. was incorporated by letters patent issued on 9 December 1950 under the Quebec Companies Act (R.S.Q., 1941, chapter 276) and was dissolved on 25 May 1974 under the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., 1964, chapter 273);

Whereas the corporation is not entitled to resumption under the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22);

Whereas it is expedient to authorize the filing of a request for the resumption of Abar Realities Inc. under section 11 of the Companies Information Act;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Any interested person may, pursuant to section 11 of the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22), make a request in writing to the Minister for Finance for the resumption of Abar Realities Inc.

2. The Minister for Finance may grant, in accordance with the Companies Information Act, a request made to him pursuant to section 1.
