## **An Act respecting Interprovincial Pipe Line (Quebec) Inc.**

WHEREAS Interprovincial Pipe Line (Quebec) Inc. is a body corporate duly incorporated in 1990 under the Canada Business Corporations Act (R.S.C., 1985, chapter C-44) and having a place of business in Montréal;

Whereas Interprovincial Pipe Line (Quebec) Inc. intends to construct, operate and maintain a pipeline to be used for the transmission of oil and oil by-products from and within the area of the city of Québec to and within the area of the city of Montréal;

Whereas it is in the public interest and necessary for the realization of that project that additional powers be granted to Interprovincial Pipe Line (Quebec) Inc.;

### THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**1.** Interprovincial Pipe Line (Quebec) Inc. may acquire, by mutual agreement or by expropriation, any immovable or real right related to the construction, operation and maintenance of a pipeline to be used for the transmission of oil and oil by-products from and within the area of the city of Québec to and within the area of the city of Montréal.

**2.** A representative of the corporation may enter at any reasonable hour onto any immovable to effect any work for the construction, operation and maintenance of the pipeline upon condition that the corporation indemnify any person for any damage caused by its representative.
