EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill amends the Courts of Justice Act in order to allow the Government to prescribe, in a tariff applicable in civil matters, court costs and court office fees varying according to whether they are payable by a natural person or a legal person.

An Act to amend the Courts of Justice Act

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 224 of the Courts of Justice Act (R.S.Q., chapter T-16), amended by section 11 of chapter 20 of the statutes of 1991, is again amended by inserting the words “prescribe costs and fees varying according to whether they are payable by a natural person or a legal person, or” after the word “tariff,” in the second line of the first paragraph.
