EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill provides that in the future the mandate of the Conseil des Communautés culturelles et de l'Immigration will concern matters relating to cultural communities and the integration of immigrants.

In addition, the bill abolishes the two vice-president's positions on the Conseil and redefines the duties of the president.

Bill 122

An Act to amend the Act respecting the Conseil des Communautés culturelles et de l'Immigration

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 3 of the Act respecting the Conseil des Communautés culturelles et de l'Immigration (R.S.Q., chapter C-57.2) is amended

(1) by replacing the first paragraph by the following paragraph:

“3. The Conseil is composed of fifteen members, including a president, appointed by the Government.”;

(2) by replacing the word “Six” at the beginning of the first line of the second and third paragraphs by the word “Seven”.

2. Section 5 of the said Act is amended by replacing the first paragraph by the following paragraph:

“5. The president is appointed for not more than five years.”

3. Section 7 of the said Act is replaced by the following section:

“7. The president is responsible for the administration and general management of the Conseil.

He shall carry out his duties on a full-time basis.”

4. Section 8 of the said Act is amended by replacing the word “vice-presidents” in the second and third lines by the word “members”.

5. Section 9 of the said Act is replaced by the following section:

9. The Government shall fix the remuneration, social benefits and other conditions of employment of the president and of the member designated in accordance with section 8, for the period during which he replaces the president.”

6. Section 10 of the said Act is amended by striking out the words “and the vice-presidents” in the first and second lines.

7. Section 13 of the said Act is amended by replacing the word “immigration” in the third line by the words “the integration of immigrants”.

8. Section 14 of the said Act is amended by replacing the word “immigration” in paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 by the words “the integration of immigrants”.

9. Section 15 of the said Act is amended by replacing the word “immigration” in the second line by the words “the integration of immigrants”.

10. Notwithstanding section 1 of this Act, any vice-president in office on (*insert here the date of the day preceding the day on which this Act is assented to*) shall remain in office until the expiry of his term as vice-president.

11. This Act comes into force on (*insert here the date of assent to this Act*).
