EXPLANATORY NOTE

*The object of this bill is to change the name of the electoral division of Pointe-aux-Trembles to that of Marcel-Léger.*

## Bill 196

### **An Act respecting the electoral division of Marcel-Léger**

WHEREAS Marcel Léger, who died on 5 February 1993, played a significant role in Québec's parliamentary government in the fifteen years he was a Member of the National Assembly;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.** The name of the electoral division of Pointe-aux-Trembles is replaced by that of “Marcel-Léger”.
- 2.** In any Act, regulation or order, the expression “electoral division of Pointe-aux-Trembles”, wherever it appears, is replaced by the expression “electoral division of Marcel-Léger”.
- 3.** The chief electoral officer shall see to the application of this Act and take every measure necessary to publicize the change of name.
- 4.** This Act comes into force on *(insert here the date of assent to this Act)*.
