An Act respecting the town of Amos

WHEREAS under the Act to amend the charter of the town of Amos (1940, chapter 100), the Public Utility Commission of the Town of Amos is responsible for the administration of any public utility system which the town may have built, acquired or operated after the adoption of that Act, in addition to the waterworks system;

Whereas under the letters patent respecting the amalgamation of the town of Amos with the municipality of Amos-Est on 16 December 1986, chapter 100 of the statutes of 1940 continues to apply to the new town of Amos;

Whereas the town of Amos wishes to abolish the Public Utility Commission of the Town of Amos;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Notwithstanding section 3 of the letters patent respecting the amalgamation of the town of Amos with the municipality of Amos-Est, issued and delivered by the Government under the Great Seal of Québec on 16 December 1986, the Act to amend the charter of the town of Amos (1940, chapter 100) ceased to have effect on 1 January 1993.
