An Act respecting the city of Gatineau

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the city of Gatineau that certain powers be granted to it;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The city may, out of its revenues provided for in each year's budget, create a reserve fund limited to \$7 000 000 for the purpose of funding its self-insurance plan.

The amount allotted each year by the city for such purpose may not exceed 1 % of the budget.

2. Section 11 of the Act respecting the city of Gatineau (1992, chapter 70) is amended by replacing the words “at the following sitting” in the fourth and fifth lines by the words “at or before the second ensuing sitting”.

3. Section 2 of the Act respecting the city of Gatineau (1983, chapter 70) is repealed.

4. Alienations carried out by the city and contained in the deeds registered in the registry office of the registration division of Hull under numbers 448126, 449320, 454368, 458950 and 462432 may not be invalidated on the grounds that the city had not obtained the authorizations required under section 6 of the Act respecting municipal industrial immovables (R.S.Q., chapter I-0.1).
