An Act respecting the town of La Prairie

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the town of La Prairie that it be granted certain powers;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The special tax provided for in by-laws 508, 516, 526, 543, 545, 654, 659, 666, 694, 709, 719, 730, 731, 755, 761, 777 and 843-E of the town may not be invalidated on the ground that it was not collected in accordance with the said by-laws as regards the taxation base and the territory subject to the tax.

2. Section 1 has effect in respect of every fiscal year prior to 1994.

3. This Act shall not affect cases pending on 22 May 1993.
