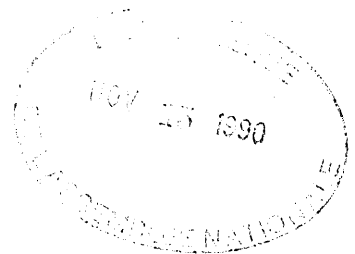

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill again amends the Act respecting family assistance allowances to give effect to a measure announced in the Budget Speech delivered by the Minister of Finance on 26 April 1990. That measure extends from three to four years the period over which the allowance for newborn children is paid in respect of a third or subsequent child.

An Act to again amend the Act respecting family assistance allowances

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 9 of the Act respecting family assistance allowances (R.S.Q., chapter A-17), enacted by section 2 of chapter 4 of the statutes of 1989 and amended by section 4 of the Act to amend the Act respecting family assistance allowances (1990, chapter 37), is again amended by replacing the words “three years” wherever they appear in the first, fourth and fifth paragraphs by the words “four years”.

2. Section 1 applies, in respect of a third or subsequent child having reached three years of age before 1 May 1990, for the quarters beginning after the month of March 1990.

Furthermore, every family is entitled, in respect of a third or subsequent child having reached four years of age during the month of May 1990, to one quarterly payment of the allowance for newborn children provided for in section 9 of the Act respecting family assistance allowances.

3. Sections 1 and 2 have effect from 1 May 1990.
