#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*The object of this bill is to provide a clearer definition of the power of the Fonds d'aide aux recours collectifs to grant further assistance for an appeal against a judgment which decides the questions of law or fact dealt with collectively and establish the criteria on which the decision of the Fonds may be based.*

## Bill 93

### **An Act to amend the Act respecting the class action**

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**1.** Section 23 of the Act respecting the class action (R.S.Q., chapter R-2.1) is amended by inserting, after the second paragraph, the following paragraph:

“Where the representative or a member requesting to be substituted for him intends to appeal the judgment which decides the questions of law or fact dealt with collectively, the Fonds, in order to determine whether to grant or terminate assistance, shall assess whether the action may be continued without such assistance and whether the appeal is likely to succeed if brought.”
