EXPLANATORY NOTES

The object of this bill is to amend the Act respecting the Ministère des Approvisionnements et Services in order to specify the matters which may be dealt with in the policies and regulations the Minister of Supply and Services is authorized to establish.

In addition, the bill specifies the powers authorizing the Minister to establish tables and identify categories of property and services as well as specialties under which suppliers may be registered for purposes of selection of suppliers by means of a register.

Lastly, the bill makes certain concordance amendments.

Bill 103

An Act to amend the Act respecting the Ministère des Approvisionnement et Services

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 7 of the Act respecting the Ministère des Approvisionnements et Services (R.S.Q., chapter M-23.01) is amended by replacing the words “acquisition and provision” in the second line of the first paragraph by the words “purchase and construction of property as well as to the leasing and supply”.

2. Section 8 of the said Act is amended by inserting the words “and construction of property as well as to the leasing” after the word “purchase” in the fourth line of paragraph 3.

3. The said Act is amended by inserting, after section 8, the following section:

“3.1 The Minister shall establish tables listing categories of property or goods, categories of services and specialties under which suppliers may be registered for purposes of selection of suppliers by means of a register. These tables shall be submitted to the Government for approval and published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.”

4. Section 9 of the said Act is amended by inserting the words “and construction of property as well as the leasing” after the word “purchase” in the third line of the second paragraph.

5. This Act comes into force on (*insert here the date of assent to this Act*).
