EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this bill is to amend the Charter of the French language in order to prohibit anyone from preventing a pupil from communicating at school in a language other than French outside a period in which an educational service, at the primary or secondary level, or a developmental and cognitive learning service, at the preschool level, is provided to the pupil.

An Act to amend the Charter of the French language

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Charter of the French language (R.S.Q., chapter C-11) is amended by inserting, after section 78.1, the following section:

“78.2 No person may prohibit or otherwise prevent a pupil from communicating at school in a language other than French outside a period in which an educational service, at the primary or secondary level, or a developmental and cognitive learning service, at the preschool level, is provided to the pupil.”
