An Act to amend the charter of Le Club de Golf de St-Hyacinthe Limitée

WHEREAS Le Club de Golf de St-Hyacinthe Limitée was incorporated under Part I of the Quebec Companies Act (R.S.Q., 1925, chapter 223) by letters patent issued on 7 February 1929;

Whereas this corporation subsequently came to be governed by chapter 100 of the statutes of 1962 and by the provisions of Part II of the Companies Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-38);

Whereas it seeks no pecuniary advantage and may not declare or pay any dividend;

Whereas, at a special general meeting called for such purpose on 20 February 1989, the shareholders of the corporation agreed unanimously that section 15 of the charter of the corporation be repealed to permit the corporation to increase the value of the immovable property that it may own;

Whereas for the proper administration of its affairs and the pursuit of its objects, it is necessary to make this amendment;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.** Section 15 of chapter 100 of the statutes of 1962 is repealed.
