An Act respecting American Realty Investors Corp.

WHEREAS American Realty Investors Corp., a company having its head office in Montréal, Province of Québec, was incorporated by letters patent issued on 25 April 1962 under Part I of the Quebec Companies Act (R.S.Q., 1941, chapter 276);

Whereas the company was dissolved on 1 December 1973 under the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., 1964, chapter 273) for failure to furnish a return;

Whereas, since 1 December 1973, the officers, directors and shareholders of the company have been proceeding as if the company were still in existence, having only recently learned of its dissolution;

Whereas the company is not entitled to resume existence under the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22);

Whereas it is expedient to authorize the filing of a request for the resumption of American Realty Investors Corp. under section 11 of the Companies Information Act;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Any interested person may, in accordance with section 11 of the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22), make a request in writing to the Minister for Finance for the resumption of American Realty Investors Corp.

2. The Minister for Finance may grant, in accordance with the Companies Information Act, a request made to him pursuant to section 1.
