An Act respecting the city of Saint-Hyacinthe

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the city of Saint-Hyacinthe that certain powers be granted to it;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The city of Saint-Hyacinthe is authorized to establish and operate a convention centre.

The city may assume the management of the convention centre or entrust such management to any person, business firm or corporation and sign any agreement for that purpose.

2. The city is authorized to grant subsidies to institutions, firms or corporations engaged in the pursuit of the above mentioned objectives.
