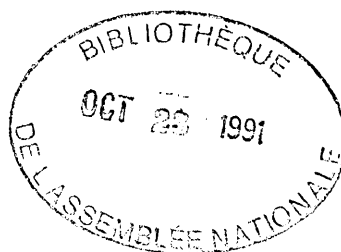

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This bill is intended to allow the court, on the request of the Public Curator, to proceed with the institution or review of protective supervision of a person of full age in need thereof without holding a family council, if the Public Curator proves that sufficient effort has been made to call the council and that such effort has been in vain.*

## Bill 159

### An Act to amend the Civil Code of Lower Canada with respect to tutorship and curatorship

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**1.** The Civil Code of Lower Canada is amended by inserting, after article 331.4, the following article:

**“331.5** Where the Public Curator requires the institution or review of protective supervision and proves that sufficient effort has been made to call a family council and that such effort has been in vain, the court may proceed without a family council being held.”
