EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this bill is to change the name of the electoral division of Bertrand to that of Marguerite-d'Youville.

Bill 195

An Act respecting the electoral division of Marguerite-d'Youville

WHEREAS the National Assembly has paid homage to Sister Marguerite d'Youville on 12 December 1990 to underline her canonization, making her the first saint born in New France;

Whereas this extraordinary person has played an outstanding role in our national history;

Whereas Sister Marguerite d'Youville was born in the region comprised within the limits of the present electoral division of Bertrand and she arouses great pride in the population of that electoral division;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The name of the electoral division of Bertrand is replaced by that of “Marguerite-d'Youville”.

2. In any Act, regulation or order, the expression “electoral division of Bertrand”, wherever it appears, is replaced by the expression “electoral division of Marguerite-d'Youville”.

3. The chief electoral officer shall see to the application of this Act and take every measure necessary to publicize the change of name.
