An Act respecting Mélançon et Fils Inc.

WHEREAS Mélançon et Fils Inc. was incorporated by letters patent issued on 17 July 1956 pursuant to the Quebec Companies Act (R.S.Q., 1941, chapter 276) and was dissolved on 10 February 1973 pursuant to the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., 1964, chapter 273);

Whereas since 10 February 1973, Mélançon et Fils Inc. has ceased to do business and, consequently, has not complied with the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22);

Whereas the corporation is not entitled to resume existence under the Companies Information Act;

Whereas it is expedient to authorize the filing of a request for the resumption of Mélançon et Fils Inc. under section 11 of the Companies Information Act;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Any interested person may, in accordance with section 11 of the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22), make a request in writing to the Minister for Finance for the resumption of Mélançon et Fils Inc.

2. The Minister for Finance may grant, in accordance with the Companies Information Act, a request made to him pursuant to section 1.
