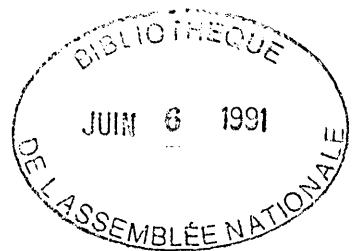

An Act respecting the city of Saint-Hyacinthe

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the city of Saint-Hyacinthe that it be granted certain powers;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The city is authorized to acquire the immovable described in the schedule in accordance with section 5 of the Act to amend the charter of the city of Saint-Hyacinthe (1982, chapter 117).

Notwithstanding the third and fourth paragraphs of section 6 of the said Act, amended by section 287 of chapter 38 of the statutes of 1984, the city may alienate the immovable for housing purposes for an amount less than its actual value or cost of acquisition, provided the alienation is carried out by auction or public tenders.

2. This Act comes into force on *(insert here the date of assent to this Act)*.

An immovable consisting of lots 152-2, 153-1-2 and 154-2 of the cadastre of the parish of Saint-Hyacinthe-le-Confesseur, registration division of Saint-Hyacinthe.
