An Act to repeal certain statutory provisions

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

The object of this bill is to repeal certain revised statutes which have become obsolete. It also repeals a provision purposely omitted from the Revised Statutes of 1977 and makes the required concordance amendments.

The bill further provides that the Government may make an order before 1 July 1989 to prevent the repeal of all or part of any of the Acts or the provision mentioned in section 1. However, the order must be approved by the Committee on Institutions of the National Assembly before the deadline of 1 July.

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THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following are repealed:

- (1) the Publishers Loss Insurance Act (R.S.Q., chapter A-27);
- (2) the Guarantee Companies Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-43);
- (3) the Act respecting cold storage warehouses for fish and bait (R.S.Q., chapter E-12);
- (4) the Theatrical Performances Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-25);
- (5) the Act respecting mineral exploration partnerships (R.S.Q., chapter S-26);
- (6) the Railway Ticket Sales Act (R.S.Q., chapter V-2);
- (7) section 5 of the Guarantee Companies Act (R.S.Q., 1964, chapter 288).

2. Section 334 of the Act respecting industrial accidents and occupational diseases (R.S.Q., chapter A-3.001) is amended by replacing the words “, the Act respecting Insurance (chapter A-32) or the Guarantee Companies Act (chapter C-43)” in the ninth and tenth lines of the second paragraph by the words “or the Act respecting insurance (chapter A-32)”.

3. Section 20.25 of the Retail Sales Tax Act (R.S.Q., chapter I-1), amended by section 4 of chapter 21 of the statutes of 1987, is again amended by striking out subparagraph iii of paragraph *m*.

4. The Government may, by way of an order made before 1 July 1989, exclude from the application of section 1 all or part of any Act mentioned in paragraphs 1 to 6 of the said section or of the provision mentioned in paragraph 7 of the said section and indicate, where such is the case, which amending provisions enacted by sections 2 and 3 are consequently inoperative. The order shall be laid before the Committee on Institutions of the National Assembly and shall have effect only if approved by the Committee prior to such date.

5. This Act comes into force on (*insert here the date of assent to this Act*).

Sections 1 to 3 have effect from 1 July 1989.
