EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill provides that the Commission québécoise des libérations conditionnelles will be composed of seven full-time members.

In addition, the bill authorizes the chairman of the Commission to designate a part-time member to replace a full-time member who is temporarily absent or unable to act.

An Act to amend the Act to promote the parole of inmates

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 3 of the Act to promote the parole of inmates (R.S.Q., chapter L-1.1) is amended by replacing the word “six” in the first line by the word “seven”.

2. Section 9 of the said Act is amended by adding, at the end, the following paragraphs:

“Where a full-time member is temporarily absent or unable to act, the chairman may designate a part-time member to replace the member who is absent or unable to act, until a person is appointed by the Government under the first paragraph.

Any person appointed or designated under this section is deemed to be a full-time member for the purposes of section 11.”
