EXPLANATORY NOTE

The bill amends the Dispensing Opticians Act in order to allow, subject to certain conditions, the use, in the firm name, of the name of any partner who has ceased to practise his profession.

An Act to amend the Dispensing Opticians Act

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 12 of the Dispensing Opticians Act (R.S.Q., chapter O-6) is amended by adding, after the word “partners” at the end of the second paragraph, the following sentence: “The name of any partner who has ceased to practise his profession may appear in the firm name for a period of not more than three years from the date he ceased to practise, provided such name appeared in the firm name at the time he ceased to practise.”
