EXPLANATORY NOTES

The object of this bill is to authorize the acquisition, by the Minister of Transport, of new passenger cars for the commuter railway line between Rigaud and Montréal.

The new passenger cars will be transferred by the Minister to the Société de transport de la Communauté urbaine de Montréal which will, from that time, assume the rights and obligations of the Minister under the terms of the contract binding him to the manufacturer.

An Act respecting the acquisition of cars for the railway line between the city of Montréal and the town of Rigaud

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Minister of Transport is authorized to acquire twenty-four passenger cars, including spare parts, for the railway line between the city of Montréal and the town of Rigaud.

2. The cars and spare parts acquired by the Minister shall be transferred to the Société de transport de la Communauté urbaine de Montréal.

3. The Société shall acquire the rights and assume the obligations of the Minister under the contract binding the latter to the manufacturer. It shall, however, pay the sales tax in accordance with the Retail Sales Tax Act (R.S.Q., chapter I-1).

4. This Act comes into force on (*insert here the date of assent to this Act*). However, section 1 has effect from 11 July 1988.
