**An Act respecting the town
of Métabetchouan**

WHEREAS it is appropriate to validate a by-law ordering municipal city works, to establish the date of its coming into force and to validate the contract granted by the town for their execution;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The by-law 30-77 of the town of Métabetchouan, ordering the construction of a municipal building and authorizing a loan of \$758 500 in order to defray its costs, is hereby declared valid and deemed to be in force since 14 October 1977.

2. The contract entered into by the town of Métabetchouan and Laval Fortin Ltée on 31 October 1977 for the construction of a municipal building ordered by by-law 30-77, is hereby declared to be valid from that date.
