An Act respecting Elzéar Plourde Ltée

WHEREAS Elzéar Plourde Ltée, a corporation incorporated by letters patent on 16 August 1946 under Part I of the Quebec Companies Act (R.S.Q., 1941, chapter 276), was dissolved on 15 July 1972 under the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., 1964, chapter 273);

Whereas the corporation is not entitled to resumption under the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22);

Whereas it is expedient to authorize the presentation of a request for the resumption of Elzéar Plourde Ltée under section 11 of the Companies Information Act;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Any interested person may, pursuant to section 11 of the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22), make a request in writing to the Minister responsible for the administration of the Companies Information Act for the resumption of Elzéar Plourde Ltée.

2. The Minister responsible for the administration of the Companies Information Act may, in accordance with the Companies Information Act, grant a request received pursuant to section 1.
