An Act respecting the city of Côte Saint-Luc

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the city of Côte Saint-Luc to regularize a situation resulting from the existence of certain servitudes in its territory;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Every right of way which may have resulted from the qualification of certain immovables as lanes by the subdivision plan of a part of lots 109 and 111 of the cadastre of the municipality of the parish of Montréal, deposited at the Department of Colonization, Mines and Fisheries on 27 May 1912, and by the subdivision plan of a part of lot 113 of the said cadastre, deposited at the same department on 23 October 1912, and by the books of reference deposited with such plans, is hereby cancelled.
