# Bill 286

## **An Act respecting the town of Lac-Etchemin**

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the town of Lac-Etchemin that it be granted certain powers following the loss of the book containing the minutes of the proceedings, votes and deliberations of the council for the period extending from 24 October 1977 to 30 June 1988;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**1.** The town of Lac-Etchemin may, by means of writings, photocopies of documents or declarations in writing by a person having knowledge of the facts, reconstitute the minutes of the proceedings, votes and deliberations of the council for the period extending from 24 October 1977 to 30 June 1988. The minutes, once approved by resolution of the council, shall be deposited at the office of the secretary-treasurer.

Public notice of the deposit of the minutes shall be published in accordance with section 345 of the Cities and Towns Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-19).

**2.** Any judge of the Superior Court sitting in the judicial district of Beauce may, on a motion by the city and on such conditions as he determines, homologate the minutes. The minutes, once homologated, shall stand in lieu of the original minutes.

The motion shall not be granted unless a notice of presentation of not less than 90 days indicating that the minutes have been deposited at the office of the secretary-treasurer, that any person may consult them and that any interested person may object to their

homologation is published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* and in a newspaper distributed in the municipality.
