EXPLANATORY NOTES

The object of this bill is to allow persons other than pharmacists to continue to prepare and sell medicinal foods until 31 August 1986.

This case constitutes an exception to the exclusive right of pharmacists to practise in this area pursuant to section 17 of the Pharmacy Act (R.S.Q., chapter P-10).

An Act respecting an exception to the Pharmacy Act

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Notwithstanding section 17 of the Pharmacy Act (R.S.Q., chapter P-10), persons who on 20 June 1984 were preparing or selling medicinal food may continue to perform those acts until 31 August 1986 provided they comply with every other Act or regulation applicable to them.

2. This Act comes into force on 1 January 1986.
