EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill provides that the members of the Conseil des universités remain in office at the end of their terms until they are reappointed or replaced.

It also provides that if the president is unable to act, the Government may appoint a person to replace him while he is incapacitated.

An Act to amend the Act respecting the Conseil des universités

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 7 of the Act respecting the Conseil des universités (R.S.Q., chapter C-58) is amended by inserting, after the second paragraph, the following paragraph:

“At the end of their term, the members of the Council shall remain in office until they are reappointed or replaced.”

2. The said Act is amended by inserting, after section 8, the following section:

“**8.1** If the president is unable to act, he may be replaced by a person appointed by the Government to perform the duties of the president for as long as he is unable to act. The Government shall fix the remuneration, social benefits and other conditions of employment of the person appointed.”
